ATLAS AMBASSADORS PROGRAM

ATLAS Ambassador Program is an award of financial encouragement to facilitate the student's academic achievement at ATLAS. The ATLAS Ambassador rewards excellence by supporting high achieving students with financial need who seek to attend our professional regular programs at ISDI/ ISME/ VFS.

Types of Scholarships / Financial assistance available

Based on students' expectation and context, ATLAS is providing following types of Scholarships:

1. *Merit Scholarships*
2. *Need Based Financial Assistance*

Merit Scholarships

In ATLAS, the Ambassador's Program encourages students to excel in academics, offering merit-based scholarships in UG and PG studies. Students who have worked hard to maintain high academic grades, can apply for the Scholarship program. Students applying for the merit scholarship must clear the eligibility criteria.

Eligibility for UG studies

- Students who have scored an aggregate of 90% or above (CBSE, ICSE, CIE and State Boards Examination) in all subjects in class X are eligible to apply for UG Merit based Scholarships. For students who have completed grade XII at the time of applying for scholarship, the aggregate of all subjects of grade XII, will be considered and must be 90% or more.

Supporting documents (applicant can submit)

- A written letter of recommendation from School or College Counselor / Principal should be attached along with scholarship application.
- Proof of any extracurricular activities, participation in sports, display of entrepreneurial pursuits, demonstration of leadership qualities, social responsibility projects undertaken may be attached along with the scholarship application.

Eligibility for PG studies

- Students with the grades of 90% or equivalent and above in class XII and 75% in Graduation, are eligible to apply for Merit Scholarship.
- Student's performance in The ISDI Challenge (Entrance exam) will be considered.
- A written letter of recommendation from School or College Counselor / Principal should be attached along with scholarship application.
- Proof of any extracurricular activities, participation in sports, display of entrepreneurial pursuits, demonstration of leadership qualities, social responsibility projects undertaken may be attached along with the scholarship application.

Need based financial assistance

We believe nothing should come in the way of quality education to deserving students, least of all, financial constraints. The ATLAS Ambassador's program offers financial assistance for UG and PG programs.

The Need based financial assistance are awarded based on the families' financial background.

Eligibility for UG studies

- Students with annual gross family income from all sources amounting to a maximum Rs 12,00,000/- can apply in this category.
- Applicants must submit copies of last 3 financial year's Income Tax Return, Salary Certificate, Annual Income Declaration, or affidavit of all member/s of the family filing for tax, along with a note on any other considerations (such as medical treatment expenses, loss of employment, etc).
- Students who have availed of financial assistance will not be eligible to apply for the international transfer programs.
- Children whose parent(s) have served or are currently serving in the Indian Armed Forces will be considered favorably for scholarship. Children who have been awarded financial assistance on this ground will be eligible for the international transfer programs.
- Children whose parent(s) are academicians and where the significant income of the family comes from teaching will be considered favorably for scholarship. Children who have been awarded financial assistance on this ground will be eligible for the international transfer programs.

Eligibility for PG studies

- Students with annual gross family income from all sources amounting to a maximum Rs 12,00,000/- can apply in this category.
- Applicants must submit copies of last 3 financial year's Income Tax Return, Salary Certificate, Annual Income Declaration, or affidavit of all member/s of the family filing for tax, along with a note on any other considerations (such as medical treatment expenses, loss of employment, etc).

Process of applying for Scholarship / Financial Assistance

Students who have received an admission offer letter from ISDI and have completed the enrolment process are eligible to apply for scholarship / financial assistance. Students looking for Lateral Admission (APL/ APEL) in Year 2 or Year 3 are not eligible to apply for a Scholarship/ Financial Assistance.
